Neetu Singh, DMD, MPH Introduction

Neetu Singh is the Oral Health Program Director at the Boston-based consumer health advocacy organization Health Care For All (HCFA). Prior to joining HCFA, Dr. Singh practiced clinical dentistry in NYC for several years. Dr. Singh returned to academia to receive her MPH from the Harvard School of Public Health and has subsequently transited her career from full-time clinical practice to health policy & advocacy. Her work focuses on increasing access and coverage of oral health and dental services for consumers in Massachusetts, developing strategies and implementing policies which support the integration of oral health into the broader health care system.



Shannon Wells, MSW Moderator

Shannon Wells is an independent consultant specializing in integrative public health. She is also the former Director of Integrated Care for the Massachusetts League of Community Health Centers. In that role, she directed multiple projects focused on improving health outcomes and accessing by integrating oral health, behavioral health and primary care on both a state and federal level. Prior to the Mass League, Shannon served as the project director for Boston Children's Hospital's Early Childhood Caries Initiative.

Christie Lumsden, PhD, MS, RD, CDN Panelist

Christie Lumsden is an Associate Research Scientist in the Section of Oral, Diagnostic, and Rehabilitation Sciences at the Columbia University College of Dental Medicine. She serves as the Research Methods Course Lead for the Columbia/ NY Presbyterian Pediatric Dentistry Residency Program, and is an active member of the College's Committee on Access, Equity and Inclusion. Dr. Lumsden's work has largely focused on designing and conducting research to encourage adoption of healthy diet-related behaviors to reduce oral health disparities in young children.

Hugh Silk is a Professor in the Department of Family Medicine and Community Health at the University of Massachusetts Medical School. He also teaches at the Harvard School of Dental Medicine. He is co-founder of the award winning national curriculum on oral health for health providers, "Smiles for Life".
